ORDINANCE NO. 190

UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE ORDINANCE

Adopted: April 13, 1999

Effective: May 21, 1999

(as amended by Ordinance Nos. 194 and 209)

An Ordinance to adopt the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages as promulgated by the Michigan Department of State Police in March 1981, with various amendments to reflect subsequent amendments to various corresponding provisions of the Michigan Vehicle Code, to provide for the public health, safety and welfare by regulating the operation of motor vehicles, bicycles, motorcycles, mopeds, snowmobiles, off-road vehicles, and other vehicles and conveyances, by regulating pedestrian movements, by designating various acts and omissions as criminal offenses or civil infractions/offenses punishable by monetary penalties and/or incarceration and/or other sanctions, and by regulating traffic and traffic conditions within the Township.

ORDAINS:

SECTION I

TRAFFIC CODE ORDINANCE PROVISIONS

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after publication as provided by law.
