OLD BUSINESS

a. Rural Residential Map update

Final refinements were discussed including isolated township parcels surrounded by village parcels. The most appropriate zoning classification for Churches (residential vs. public/recreational) was also discussed, with members favoring a residential type classification.

A public hearing will be held at our November meeting to solicit public input on several Ordinance and Map updates, primarily involving Rural Residential zoning.

b. Residential: Review of Master Plan and current zoning adjustment needs

Commission members reviewed the Township Zoning Map and Master Plan section by section, focusing primarily on residential classifications and zones. Several adjustments were discussed to achieve better alignment of the Map with the Master Plan.

REPORT FROM THE TOWNSHIP BOARD

Ken Hovenkamp updated the Commission on activities of the Board including: unusual water usage charges from the Village of Schoolcraft, Township enforcement of RV/boat parking, refinement of special assessment rolls for lake weed abatement programs, and Township Board consideration of funding future road improvements through a special assessment mechanism.
